Management of Traffic Intermediate (MOT)

- The Florida DOT Management of Traffic course will teach participants the required knowledge to create safe work zones on public roads and highways.
- This course is required by Florida Law for all persons with duties that include any of the following activities:
 - Direct responsibility for placement of work zone traffic control devices;
 - Direct responsibility for field maintenance of work zone traffic control devices;
 - Inspection of the placement or operational function of work zone traffic control devices;
 - Drafting or electronic generation of work zone traffic control plans.

Topics include:

- Classroom and field demonstration of the MUTCD, Index 600 series design standards.
- Workshop exercises selecting and setting up a number of sample work zones.
- Flagging operations and providing basic “flagger” training.
